John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life."






God the Vinedresser takes away, or disciplines, branches - believers - that don't bear fruit. He does this <u>so that</u> they can start producing good fruit! He prunes the branches that bear fruit - positive believers - <u>so that</u> they will produce more fruit! It is way more important for God to teach us who He is than to take away "pruning", or suffering. God wants us to know more about Him so we can be closer to Him. Suffering is one way He uses to teach us because we must keep our eyes on Jesus Chris in order to get through the suffering! He will never give us more than we can handle, and He'll always give us a way to get through it! Adversity and suffering will always be a part of everyone's life; we can either go through it alone - HELP! Or, we can go through it with God - AHHH!

Jesus Christ, the Vine, produces life in His branches, believers, through the power of the Holy Spirit. When we stay in the Vine, stay in the thinking of Jesus Christ, we have the life of Jesus Christ. What a life! God wants us to experience "good fruit" in time as well as in eternity. He wants us to experience the fruit of the Holy Spirit! (Galatians 5:22-23) He wants us to rely not on ourselves but on Him! The Vine is patient with His branches. We must be patient with ourselves, with others, and with God's timing. He - God - Who began a good work in us will complete it!






I'm going through some adversity.
